**BOARD RESOLUTION
FOR
SCHOOLS OF CHOICE - OPT IN
2017-2018 School Year**

WHEREAS, the Michigan legislature, under the State School Aid Act (SB 851,1966 PA 300) permits school districts to accept for enrollment non-resident students residing within the same intermediate school district (ISD).

WHEREAS, the Michigan legislature has provided a time line for implementing this non-resident enrollment option for the 2017-2018 school year as follows:

1. By June 1, 2017, determine whether or not the district will accept applications.
2. By June 14, 2017, publish the grades, schools and special programs, if any, for which applications will be accepted.
3. By July 3, 2017, accept applications.
4. By July 17, 2017, determine which non-resident applicants will be allowed to enroll in Tecumseh Public Schools and notify parents/legal guardians of acceptance.
5. Based on the number of open positions, applications will be accepted by district through the first week of school, or by September 08, 2017, and by the end of first semester on December 22, 2017.

WHEREAS, Tecumseh Public Schools supports (or recognizes) the school of choice program adopted by the Michigan legislature, and plans to implement the school of choice option for the **2017-2018** school year.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

Tecumseh Public Schools will accept applications from non-resident students residing within the local intermediate school district and contiguous counties for the 2017-2018 school year under the school of choice plan and will comply with the deadlines and requirements set forth by the law.

SCHOOLS OF CHOICE RESOLUTION – 2017-2018**

WHEREAS, Tecumseh Public Schools Board of Education approved the Schools of Choice Opt-In provision for the 2017-2018 school year,

WHEREAS, Tecumseh Public Schools must determine the number of students it will accept per grade level and program and publish the dates in which the district will accept applications from interested persons wanting to attend Tecumseh Public Schools under the Schools of Choice criteria.

NOW THEREFORE, the following criteria were determined by the Tecumseh Public Schools Board of Education at its regular meeting on March 13, 2017, as part of its School of Choice requirements for the 2017-2018 school year:

1. By June 1, 2017, determine whether or not the district will accept applications.
2. Accept the number of students in the buildings, by grade level/program, as indicated.
3. By June 14, 2017, publish the grades, schools and special programs, if any, for which applications will be accepted.
4. By July 3, 2017, accept applications.
5. By July 17, 2017, determine which non-resident applicants will be allowed to enroll in Tecumseh Public Schools and notify parents/legal guardians of acceptance.
6. In accordance with Section 105 and 105c of the Schools of Choice Act, should the number of applications exceed the number of spaces indicated and available, a selection process, by a random draw, will occur to ensure that all applicants have an equal probability of being chosen for enrollment. Further, based on the number of open positions, applications will be accepted by the school district through the first week of school, or by September 08, 2017, and by the end of first semester on December 22, 2017.

Any non-resident student(s) residing within the Lenawee Intermediate School District and contiguous counties interested in attending Tecumseh Public Schools, **must** submit a Schools of Choice Application, **which is available at the Board of Education Office**, for acceptance to the Superintendent of Schools, in compliance with the deadlines and requirements as set forth by law.
