2016-2017 Parking Permit Application

1. All student vehicles driven to school and parked in the designated areas during normal school days must have a school issued permit **displayed on the rear view mirror with the number visible from the front**. The cost of the permit is \$25.
2. Cars without permits may be TOWED away at the owners' expense. Failure to secure a permit will result in consideration for loss of parking privileges. If a student changes cars (sell, trade, etc.) or license plates, it is his/her responsibility to notify the office with the new information.
3. Each student is responsible for keeping the parking lot free of litter.
4. **Parking in the staff/visitor space or fire lines will result in disciplinary action.** Student parking is facing east/west, staff and visitor park in spots facing north/south. **See parking violation procedure below.**
5. Loitering in vehicles parking in the school parking lots is NOT permitted. Students are not allowed to be in the parking lots or enter vehicles between classes or during lunch unless excused.
6. Students must follow instructions given by the Security Officer or staff member in matters pertaining to warnings for illegal parking, speeding, loitering, etc.
7. Parking tags MAY NOT be transferred to another student's vehicle.
8. The SPEED LIMIT IS 15 MPH. Any type of unsafe driving could result in loss of parking privileges, disciplinary action and police action.
9. Tecumseh High School employs security people who are on school grounds during school hours. These individuals are employed to assist in enforcing policies and making Tecumseh High School a safe environment. If approached by one of these employees, students are to cooperate and give them their full name and show their student ID if asked. Parking lot attendants and building monitors should be treated with respect and their requests honored.

THS Parking Violation Procedures

FIRST OFFENSE: Student is called from class to move their car and a written disciplinary warning is given.

SECOND OFFENSE: Student is written up on a Discipline Notice and loses the privilege to park in THS parking lots for nine (9) weeks. Parents are notified.

THIRD OFFENSE: Student is written up on a Discipline Notice and receives penalty according to their place in the Progressive Discipline Plan and the car may be towed at the owners' expense.
